

NOBBYS SURF LIFESAVING CLUB WORK INSTRUCTION**OPERATION OF THE ALL TERRAIN VEHICLE (ATV)**

OBJECTIVE: To provide Nobbys SLSC members with a work instruction for the operation, care and maintenance of the ATV.

PARENT NSW SLS SOP: Lifesaving, LS06 Gear and Equipment, LS6.2 ATV

IMPLEMENTATION: Nobbys SLSC ATV has Conditional Registration as it is driven on public roads from the boat shed to the beach. RMS rules for conditional registration are a Class C License.

WORK INSTRUCTIONS:

- Due to insurance requirements no one under 25yrs can drive the ATV.
- ATV driver must have a current “black” license.
- ATV driver must undergo an ATV induction before driving is authorized.
- ATV KEY is kept in Radio Cabinet in Clubhouse.
- Ignition Key is Security Coded. DO NOT use any other key.
- Key has raised section on surround which needs to be facing upwards when inserted into ignition.
- Before driving ATV from Storage Shed, check Fuel level. Top up if needed from container with RED TAG. Container is located in Fuel Storage Cabinet. (It’s the big Yellow cupboard)
- Check Tire Pressures and Adjust if needed, approx. 10 psi.
- Seat belts are to be used at all times.
- Only 2 people allowed in ATV, unless in an Emergency.
- 4WD Mode must be selected when driving on Sand.
- 4WD selector switch is located on dash board.
- Do Not Drive in Salt Water.
- You will need a run up in the soft sand to get up the ramp when towing a trailer.
- A lookout must be positioned near the ramp.
- Do not reverse patrol trailer into shed, take it off and push it in.
- At the end of Patrol, hose out ATV and remove any sand from in, over or under it.
- Lock up Storage Shed.
- Return ATV Key to Radio Cupboard in Club house when finished.
