Board and Ski Series – Final Information

Summary	This circular provides competitors, coaches and spectators with the final details in regard to the running of the 2017/18 Board and Ski Series.

- The Series is open to members between the ages of Under 14 to Masters.
- The series is free to enter to encourage participation.
- Lucky door prizes will be allocated after each round.
- Competitors who participate in three rounds will have a chance to win a Kracka Racing Mal.
- All competitors must wear a fluoro pink safety vest to compete.
- All competitors must be financial and proficient prior to the first round of the series.

Entries and Late Entries:

- The online Entry form will be closed at 9am the Friday prior to each event to assist with marshalling/ recording sheets for each round.
- Late entries will be accepted on the beach on the day of the event during the allocated registration time.
- To be eligible to enter the series, competitors must be financial and proficient members of a surf club.

On Day Registration:

All competitors must register between 12 noon and 12.45pm of each round to have their names marked off and their random number clearly printed onto both of their arms.

Format:

Each round will involve a promotion and relegation system. It is based around promoting the first third of each race to the heat prior, and demoting the last third to the following heat. In cases of the first heat only the last third are demoted and in cases of the last heat only the first third are promoted. Further information is attached to this document.

Each round will involve three rounds per discipline, alternating between disciplines e.g. board, ski, board, ski, board, ski. If time permits a fourth round of heats of either or both discipline may be conducted, at the host clubs discretion.

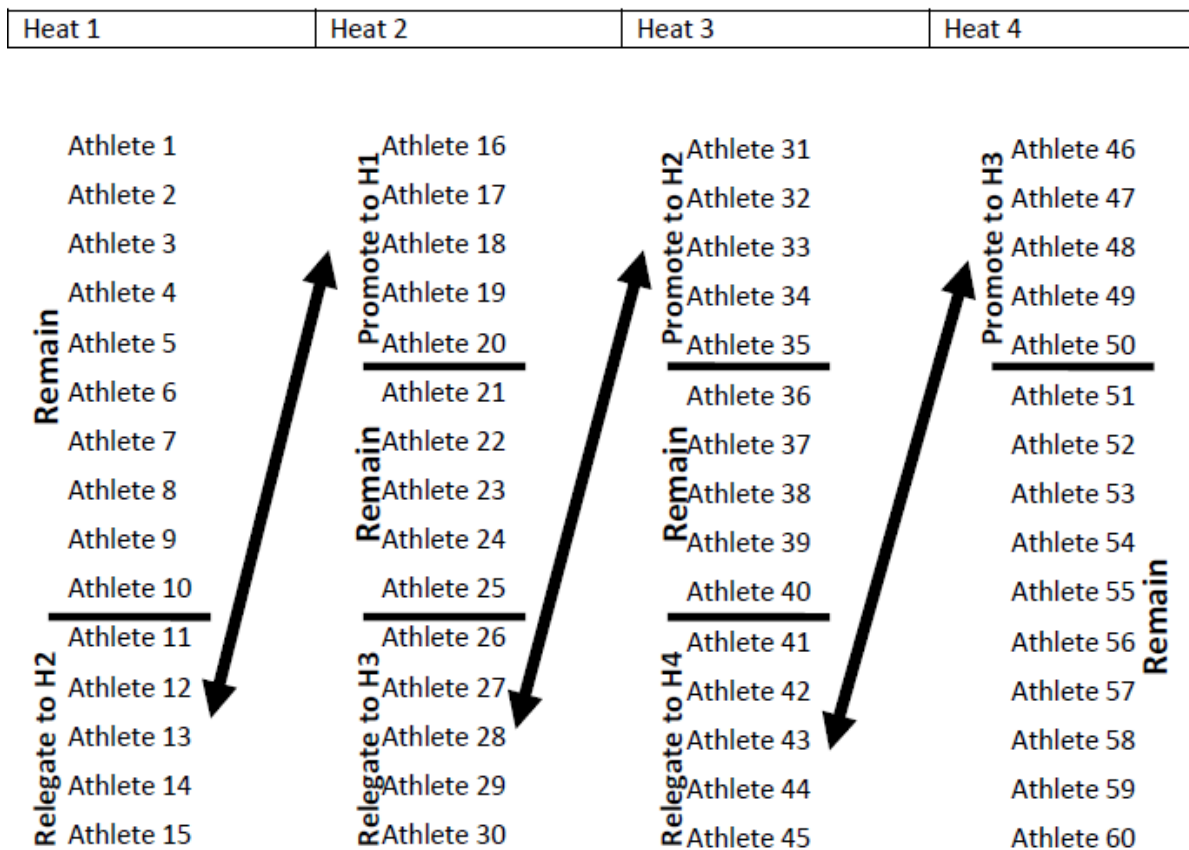
At the conclusion of the last round of heats the host club may also conduct, at the host clubs discretion, a 'king' and 'queen' of the beach.

Initial Heat Draw:

Initial heat draws will be developed at the conclusion of registration and prior to the commencement of the round. Competitors will be placed into gendered categories; male and female, unless an athlete specifically requests to compete in another gender. The athlete's heat allocation will be communicated to the athletes by the event announcer.

After the conclusion of the first round of the series, the final race recordings will be communicated back to Central Coast Branch Office as they may be used as the initial race draw for the first heats of the following round.
