With the new Officials training program HSLs has decided to only put through technical officials as we feel this will ultimately result in better run carnivals for our Competitors.

As a Technical Official you will be able to work in the following areas

- Marshall/ Check Marshall
- Starter / Check Starter
- Recorder
- Timekeeper
- Finish Judge

You will need to be 16 years +, be a club member and have your Working with Children check.

Steps to becoming an Official.

1. Contact Denise @ HSLs to register your intent to become an Official.
2. Register through the E-Learning on SLSA member area. (Cost will be \$60 Speak with your club about reimburse once you are accredited).
3. Complete the ASC Introductory Level Officiating General Principles Online Course
4. Complete being a Technical Official e-Learning Resource
5. Time to Officiate (Role Specific) e-learning Resource.
6. Work as a trainee Official at either the Lake Macquarie games at Swansea Belmont on Sunday November 12 or the Catherine Hill Bay Carnival on Sunday December 17.
7. Make yourself available to attend a Theory night at HSLs Tighes Hill on Wednesday December 13. This will run for approx. 2 hours commencing at 6pm. A great opportunity to have any questions regarding rules and protocols cleared up.
8. Once you have completed online component, Theory Night and two Carnivals, Carmel will be able to complete your paperwork and submit it the SLSNSW for accreditation.
